ABOUT CHRISTIAN PRAYER MINISTRIES

Christian Prayer Ministries is an organisation delivering one of the ministries of the Holy Spirit to the whole person, helping them to experience God's love in every area of their lives. It is a gentle, balanced, scriptural and powerful ministry within the church to Christians. It enables them to grow in their personal relationship with God and others, and become more effective in their Christian life and ministry.
